CONNECTING AND SUPPORTING STATISTICS AND DATA SCIENCE EDUCATION RESEARCHERS THROUGH THE CAUSE ORGANIZATION

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BACKGROUND AND CONTEXT

Our objective is to introduce CAUSE Research to the IASE community. The Consortium for the Advancement of Undergraduate Statistics Education (CAUSE; causeweb.org) is a U.S.-based organization with international reach whose mission is to support the advancement of undergraduate statistics and data science education. CAUSE Research is a subsidiary entity of CAUSE that seeks to promote and support the advancement of statistics and data science education research and create an inclusive environment to engage researchers from a wide range of backgrounds, experiences, and disciplines. The CAUSE organization has been a vibrant and active community for approximately 20 years. In 2021, CAUSE Research jump-started a substantial reboot to better serve statistics and data science education researchers.

CAUSE INITIATIVES
